Ipad Apps for Reading

Read Me Stories (iOS and Android)

This app is full of picture books with illustrations that children will love. While the narrator reads the book aloud, kids can follow along as the text lights up on the screen. There is a new book available for downloading every day.

Epic! (iOS)

Subscription-based service for iPads called *Epic!* helps children access a variety of texts straight from their tablet. This app helps game-ify their reading experience by awarding different bages as students complete different books.
